












PELLE is an independent design studio that combines the practices of art and engineering to create expressive lighting, furniture and design objects

The DVN table is made from 100% aluminium using Japanese joinery techniques. Minimal in appearance, the three legs of the table are measured down to 1/1000 of an inch, which allows them to be set together with the circular top

without the support of nails and fasteners. The tabletop is handfinished using a non-directional technique that amplifies the continuity of the design without visual interruptions.
